All full-time students will receive a Luis Castilleja Memorial Scholarship to cover the cost of annual membership dues.

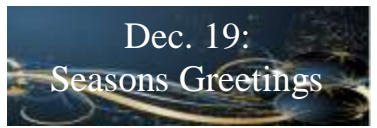
